## 2009-2010 Budget Update

After ten months of our current budget we are \$7,867.17 of income below expenses:

$$\begin{array}{r} \text{YTD Income} = \$685,758.16 \\ \text{YTD Expenses} = \$693,625.33 \\ \hline - \$7,867.17 \end{array}$$
