**SCHOOL DROP OFF** Just a quick reminder to drop children off from **7:30 -7:55 a.m.** by flag pole doors. School starts at 8 a.m., and it is hard for teachers to begin at that time if students are arriving after 7:55 a.m.

**FEVERS** Please understand that if your child has a fever in the morning before she/he is to go to school, the child should not be attending school (the child may return after being fever free for 24 hours without medication). Thank you for your cooperation.

**School age aftercare reminders:** If your child is staying for aftercare, please be sure to send an afternoon snack for your child. Also, please message over the Brightwheel app when you are here to pick up, and we will send your child out the front doors. Thank you.

**SNOW DAY PROCEDURES** If Emanuel Lutheran needs to close due to a snow situation, the school will post an announcement on the local TV stations. (channels 6, 10, & 47) School parents will get an email, a message on Brightwheel, and posted on Facebook page. Normally, **CHILDCARE WILL BE OPEN AT 7:30AM ON SNOW DAYS** unless conditions are very severe.
